**COMMUNITY BASED CCTV SCHEME
ROUND 2 ANNOUNCED**

POBAL, who administer the Community Based CCTV Scheme, have just announced the second Round of the programme.

The Community Based CCTV Scheme (which is led by the Department of Justice, Equality and Law Reform) aims to support local communities who wish to install and maintain CCTV security systems in their area, with the aim of increasing public safety and reducing the risk of anti-social and criminal activity. The Scheme is intended to support community-based organisations that wish to provide CCTV systems in order to deter illegal or anti-social behaviour in places to which the general public have routine access, such as city and town centres. The Scheme is designed to provide financial assistance, to qualifying local organisations, towards meeting the capital costs associated with the establishment of local community CCTV systems.
