CDB REVIEW COMPLETE

All County and City Development Boards in Ireland were asked to undertake an interim review of progress achieved in the implementation of their ten-year economic, social and cultural strategic plans. During this process each Board was asked to select specific actions from the 10-year strategic plan and to prioritise these for a three-year period. This in essence meant that this document would take precedence over the 10-year strategy during the period 2006 – 2008.

The review of progress to date accompanied by the reprioritised actions for 2006 – 2008 has now been completed and has been circulated. Copies of this document are available on hard copy from the office of Roscommon County Development Board or can be downloaded from their site.

The publication of this document comes out of seven months of work on behalf of the consultants who tendered for the contract and also the staff of Community & Enterprise Section, Roscommon County Council. Lengthy consultations took place between the consultants and the members of the Board and the implementation groups.
